Products including the BB2 and BB2C comply with European Community Country (ECC) regulations relating to Spill Containment.

These regulations specifically state that bunds must be able to contain 25% of the total volume of liquid stored in multiple containers or 110% of the total volume of liquid stored in a single container, whichever is greater.

The BB2 and BB2C are each designed to take up to 2no 1000lt IBC's or 8no 205lt drums, the sump capacity is 1140lt and therefore meets the requirements stated above.

The standards used in America known as the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) regulations also state the same percentages as do the Spill Prevention Control & Countermeasures (SPCC) guidance notes.

All these regulations and guidance notes apply to plastic, steel and brick built bunds.

Certain products including the BB2 are tested and certified to German DIBt standards. Please see specific documentation relating to DIBt approvals where applicable.
